
VISA REQUIREMENTS FOR STIPENDIUM HUNGARICUM SCHOLARSHIP HOLDERS

Applicants must submit their visa applications **in person** at the Embassy of Hungary in Islamabad (for personal identification and biometric data submission).

Awardees should wait to receive the **Letter of Acceptance** from their host Universities and the **Letter of Award** from Tempus Public Foundation to start the visa process.

Please note that the Embassy will not accept incomplete applications! Please take the time to review the below requirements and prepare for your visa interview.

Applicants are invited to arrange their visa application appointments by sending an email to reservation.isl@mfa.gov.hu using the following subject line: *Stipendium Hungaricum Appointment Applicant's name*.

The visas will be issued free of charge.

Applicants must include the following documents in their applications:

1. Valid passport with the previous (old) passports (at least 2 empty pages in the valid passport are needed!);
2. Copy of the data page of the passport;
3. Passport photos (colored photograph with a white background);
4. Duly completed student [visa application form and appendix](#);
5. **Letter of Acceptance** by the host University;
6. **Scholarship Award Letter** from Tempus Public Foundation;
7. **HEC contract**
8. School certificates attested by IBCC or HEC and Ministry of Foreign Affairs;
9. Accommodation:
 - a. In case of private accommodation: Notification on Accommodation form;
 - b. In case of dormitory/rented apartment: booking confirmation.
10. Flight booking;
11. Valid insurance (only travel insurance, if general insurance will be provided by the university/college);
12. Family Registration Certificate in English issued by NADRA;

13. Birth Certificate in English issued by NADRA;
14. Police clearance certificate issued by competent police department;
15. Medical examination certificate, with particular emphasis on:
 - a. Negative test certificate for HIV and Hepatitis b and c;
 - b. Lung screening results;
 - c. Certificate of absence of serious chronic and/or acute diseases.
16. CV in English;
17. Signed motivation letter in English;
18. Applicants under 18 years of age must bring certified consent letters from both parents.
